General CRS Pakistan Info

CRS has been working in Pakistan since 1954 and has programs in all 4 provinces and AJK serving disadvantaged groups regardless of ethnicity and religion. With support from a variety of donors around the world, we work with local communities and local partner organizations that serve over 100,000 people per year.

Program Areas

Specifically CRS Pakistan works in the following program areas:

- 1. Response to natural as well as man-made disasters such as droughts, floods, and earthquakes
- 2. Access to quality education for primary school students
- 3. Access to quality water for vulnerable communities
- 4. Care and support to people living with HIV and AIDS
- 5. Essential services to Afghan Refugees and other disadvantaged groups

Offices
